Trip Dates:

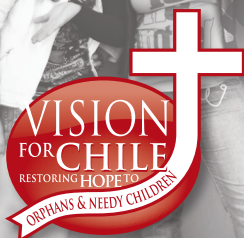
- Middle of May to the end of June, 2011
